



EVIL OFTEN WORKS THROUGH SUBTLE DISTRACTION, NOT OUTRIGHT SIN

Screwtape advises keeping the patient “safe” from dangerous truths by occupying him with comfort, small indulgences, or vague spirituality. The goal isn’t always rebellion—but distraction from what really matters.


TO SUBTLE DISTRACTIONS

Watch for subtle forms of spiritual drift—comfort, distraction, busyness—not just blatant wrongdoing.

Create habits of stillness, reflection, and meaningful focus to resist creeping moral numbness.



PRIDE IS A POWERFUL AND DISGUIISED WEAPON

Screwtape encourages Wormwood to foster spiritual pride, even in “good” behaviours. Making someone proud of being humble, or judgmental of others’ sins, is often more effective than tempting them with obvious evils.



self-examination, not superiority.



THE ENEMY (GOD) WANTS REAL FREEDOM, NOT MANIPULATION

In one of the most powerful themes, Screwtape complains that God actually wants humans to be free-thinking, loving agents, not puppets. This is frustrating for demons—because true love can't be coerced.



Choose freely to align your life with what you know is good and right—not from fear, but love.



THE "MIDDLE GROUND" IS DANGEROUS

Screwtape loves it when humans live in the illusion of being “not too good, not too bad.” He encourages lukewarm faith, spiritual compromise, and moral grey zones –because they often go unnoticed.



Evaluate your spiritual health with honesty. Are you drifting? Numb? Prioritise daily recommitment.



SUFFERING CAN BE USED FOR GROWTH— OR CORRUPTION

Screwtape sees suffering as a risk—it might draw the patient closer to God. But if he can make the patient focus on fear, self-pity, or despair, then pain becomes a weapon.




define.





TO NEGATIVE THOUGHT PATTERNS

Practice mental discipline. Replace lies with truth—read the Bible. Let your inner voice be trained by wisdom and grace.





Self-giving love is the most powerful force for spiritual resistance.


ANTIDOTE

Love practically, consistently, and humbly. Serve without needing credit.




HOW TO LIVE THIS OUT

YOUR COMMITMENT




DAILY

- Cultivate humility & growth




WEEKLY
