

with a destiny


Explanation

CHAPTER 3


OF BODIES & SPIRITS

Core Lesson

Distinction between
material and immaterial

Explanation

The soul, spirit, and body
are distinct; spiritual reality
is real and has priority over
materialism.



CHAPTER 4

IN SEARCH OF TRUE FAITH

Core Lesson

There is a unique, true faith.

Explanation

Among many religious claims, only one set of beliefs aligns with truth (from Scripture) and offers real reconciliation with God.

CHAPTER 5

CONCERNING PRAYER

Core Lesson

Prayer is vital, but must be grounded in God's truth

Explanation

Prayer isn't magic — it must align with God's will and truth, not human whim.

SHORTCUT TO TRUTH

Core Lesson

Avoid relativism and
“feelings first” shortcuts

Explanation

Relying on subjective
feelings or cultural trends
leads one away from solid
doctrine

HOW TO APPLY THESE LESSONS TO YOUR LIFE

1 PURSUE SPIRITUAL CERTAINTY

- Don't accept vague beliefs. Ask tough questions, study Scripture, and seek answers.
- Journal your doubts, research, answers, and how your conviction grows.

2 LIVE WITH ETERNAL PERSPECTIVE

- Remember every decision has eternal implications.
- In moments of comfort, decision, or temptation - ask, “What will matter 100 years from now?”

HOW TO APPLY THESE LESSONS TO YOUR LIFE

3 CULTIVATE AWARENESS OF THE INVISIBLE REALM

- Practice spiritual disciplines (meditation on Scripture, worship, solitude) to attune your spirit.
- Resist overdependence on material comforts; see life as more than what is seen.

4 DISCERN TRUTH FROM OPINION

- Test teachings by Scripture, not by popularity or emotion.
- Be willing to abandon ideas you hold if they don't align with truth.

5 LIVE WITH ETERNAL PERSPECTIVE

- Remember every decision has eternal implications.
- In moments of comfort, decision, or temptation - ask, “What will matter 100 years from now?”



HOW TO APPLY THESE LESSONS TO YOUR LIFE

6 REJECT EASY PATHS WHEN THEY MISLEAD

- Don't trust something just because it feels right in the moment.
- Build a theology rooted in reason, historic Christianity, and Scripture.

7 KNOW & SHARE THE TRUE GOSPEL

- Distil the gospel to its essentials: Christ's death, resurrection, and substitutionary atonement.
- Be ready to explain it clearly, personally, lovingly.

8 LIVE BY GRACE, NOT LEGALISM

- Accept forgiveness, don't strive for God's favour by performance.
- Let gratitude and love motivate outworking, not fear of condemnation.

HOW TO APPLY THESE LESSONS TO YOUR LIFE

WALK AS A DISCIPLE DAILY

- Commit to obedience in your relationships, work, finances, speech.
- Seek fellowship, accountability, and mentorship.

Tiny Experiment

For one week, choose one of the lessons above.

Each morning, read one short Bible verse related to it; each evening, note how you saw that principle in action (or failed).

Watch how your awareness and alignment grow.

DEVOTIONAL REFLECTION: NO SHORTCUT TO TRUTH

In a world overflowing with easy answers and instant spirituality, the heart longs for a shortcut. We want to feel close to God without the cost of surrender, to have assurance without the discipline of seeking, and to find truth without letting go of our own opinions. But Dave Hunt reminds us — there is no shortcut to truth.

Many try to substitute emotion for revelation, or experience for obedience, but the Lord has never promised that feelings would lead us right — only His Word does that.

PRAYER

Lord, keep me from the temptation to
settle for what feels true.


Teach me to love Your truth, even
